garages nor have I come across any suspicious activity/ persons except for cars that turn and leave the peninsula point when they see me.
I waved and said hello to one individual walking his dog in this hour. No more to report.

1:00-2:00

In this hour I headed back to the Jetty park/ beach for a recheck. Upon arrival there was a large group(family) on bikes at the park but they left when I parked the vehicle. I escorted three couples off of the beach and one couple off of the tower, I then told a group of fishermen to move down the rocks because they were at the Jetty park. I then headed to make rechecks of the small pier and clubhouse. The pier had the same fishermen being quiet and the clubhouse was all quiet and clear.

1:35 I noticed a black bmw with lights on sitting idle on E Balboa, plate #8bfx096. I approached and tried to get the person inside to roll the window down but it appeared as if they were asleep. I made note of it and intended to recheck soon and continued my patrol.
