The BPPA Board agreed that it is in our members interest that we do what we can to stop and/or limit future City and rental agency actions that have resulted in over concentration of short-term renters and related noise, traffic and parking issues. We continue to monitor the Drug/Alcohol Rehab Home issue and encourage everyone in our community to make themselves aware of what is happening with the proliferation of these Rehab Houses in our City and the efforts being made to curtail their growth.
